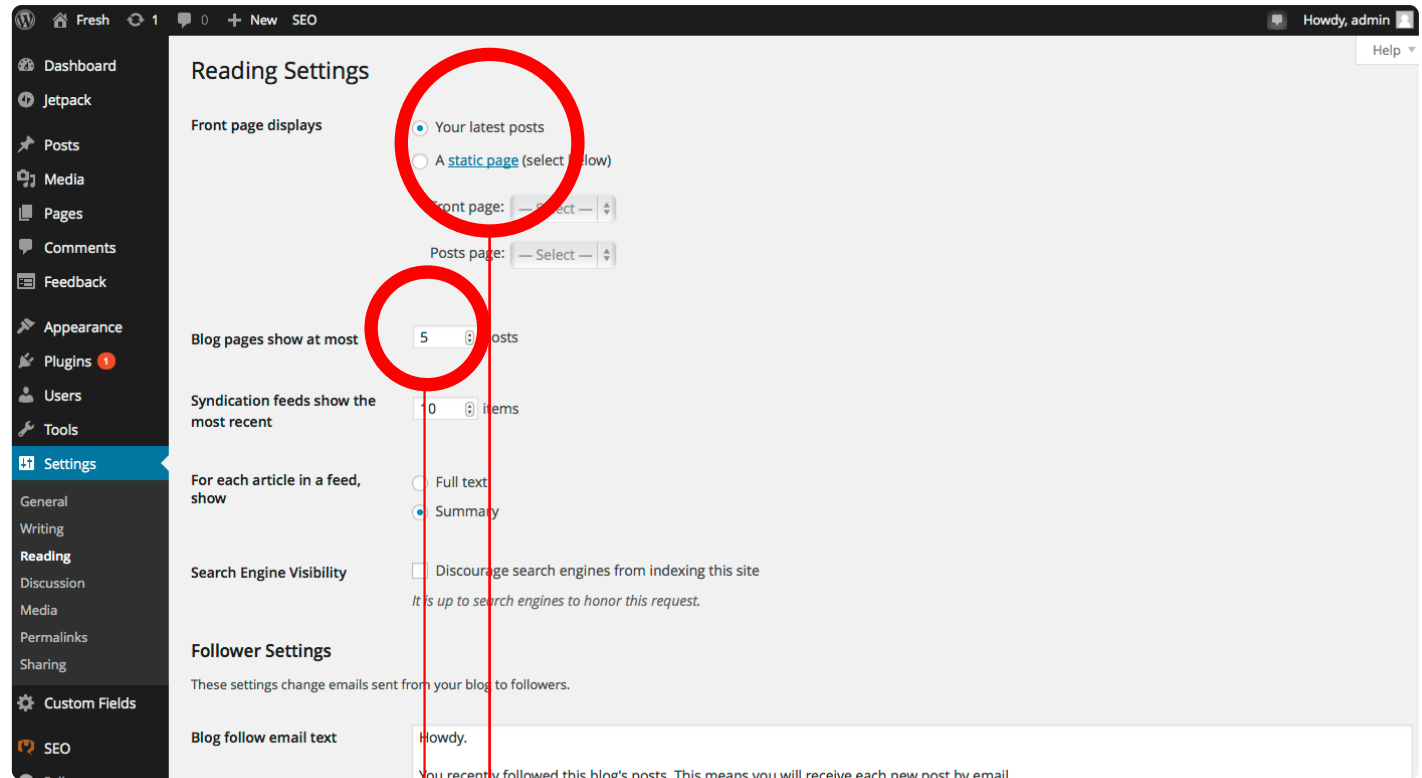

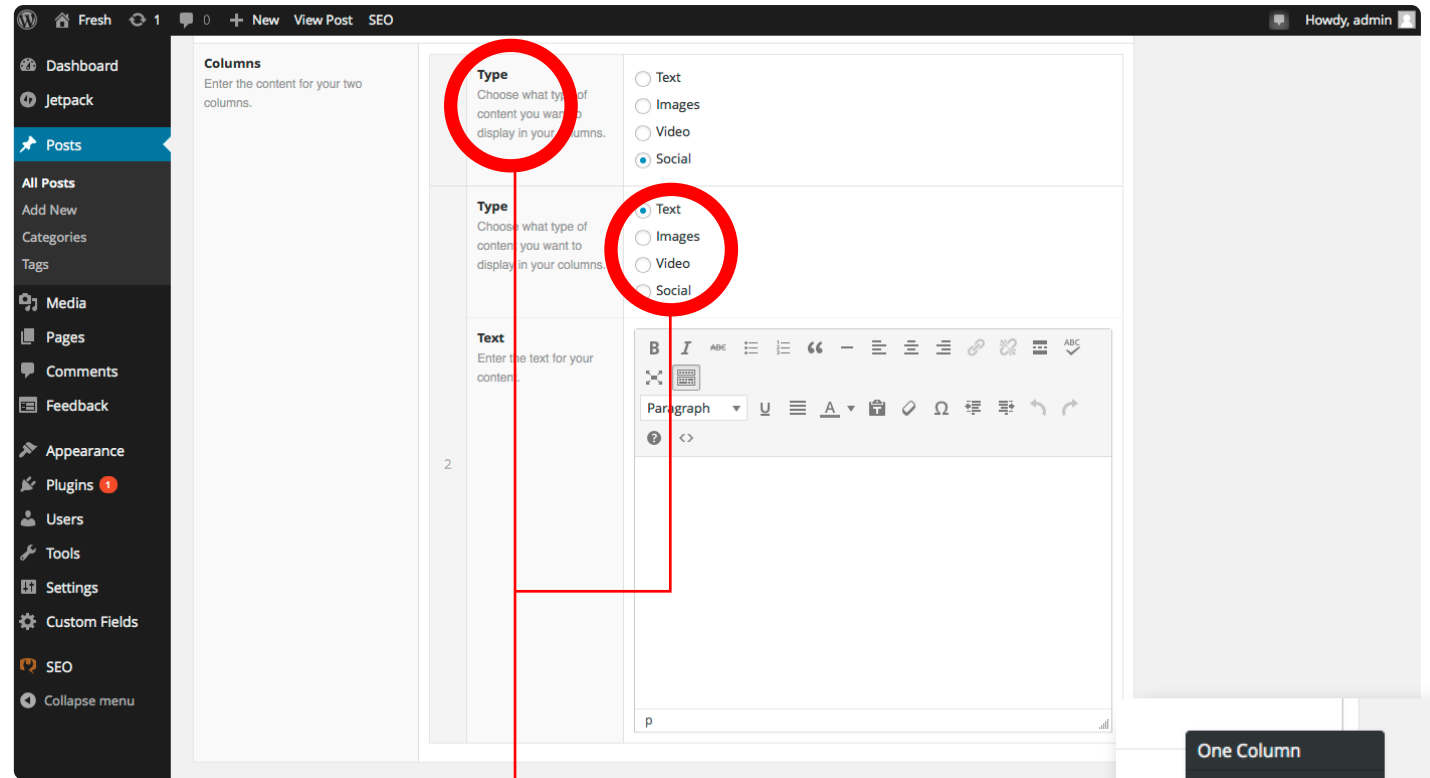

Pages work in the same way than POSTS.

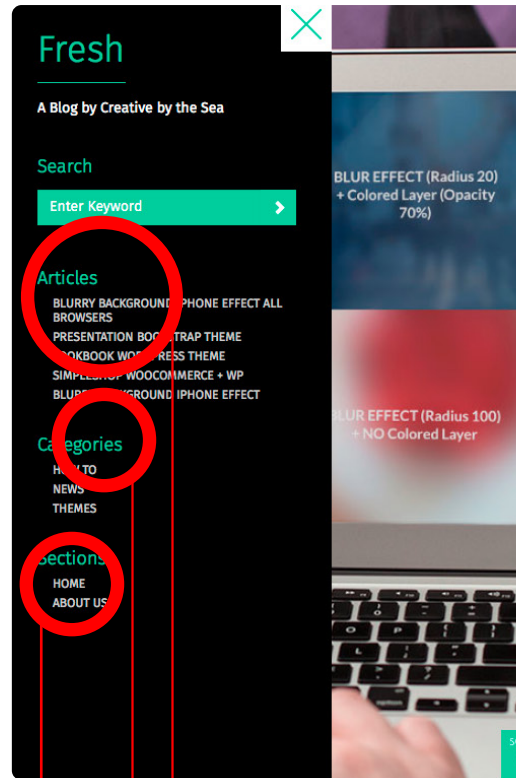
You can add a FEATURED IMAGE, and different CONTENT with the feature ADD CONTENT.

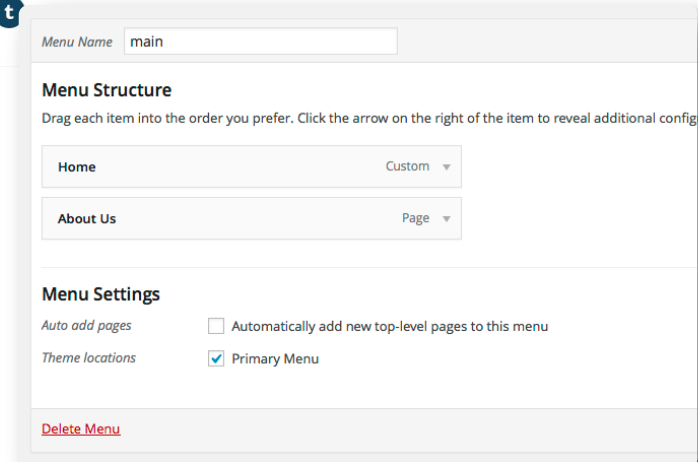

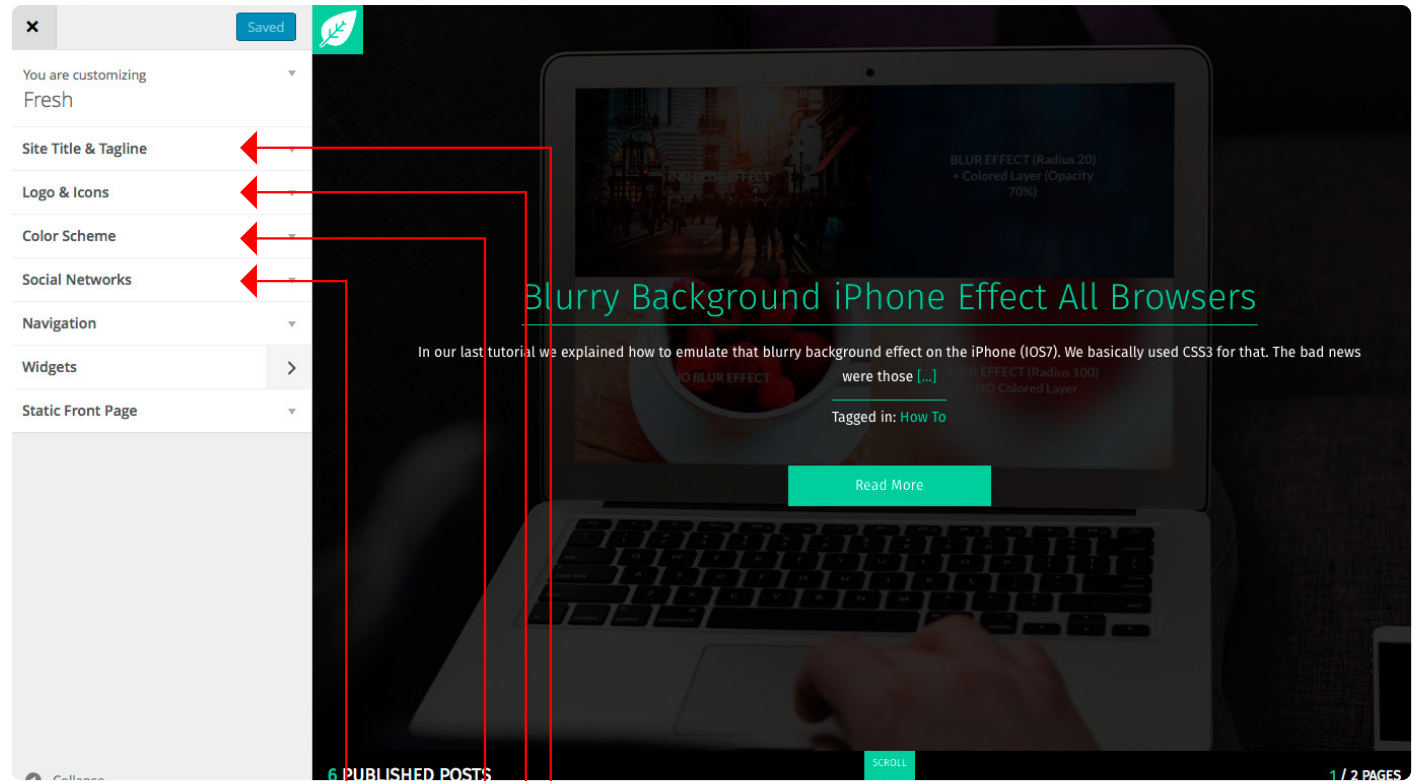
