# THEME OPTIONS


We are now going to show you using this image the tabs under theme options and what they relate to on the front page.

## These are the tabs under appearance > theme options

### TABS

- 1 - Custom header
- 2 - Branding - add a logo, image or text
- 3 - Primary menu
- 4 - Secondary BuddyPress menu
- 5 - Slideshow
- 6 - Grid view : turn on / off, set to have a link
- 7 - Social buttons
- 8 - Gallery category navigation
- 9 - Content
- 10 - Gallery menu
- 11 - Widgets
- 12 - Footer links

Home Builder is the first tab under theme options and the place where you set up everything for the home page.



## GALLERY FAQ

### HOW DO I CHANGE THE MESSAGES THAT APPEAR ON PAGES LIKE ARCHIVES AND SEARCH PAGES?

Gallery has a range of files under library/components and one of these is messages.php this is what you edit to change messages. Under the same directory headers.php is what you change for headers.

### WHAT IS A PARENT AND CHILD THEME FOR BUDDYPRESS?

We also provide child themes with all of our themes which enable you to customize your own files without having those changes overwritten when we update a theme. To find out more about parent and children themes please visit <http://premium.wpmudev.org/the-buddypress-manual/what-are-parent-and-child-themes/>.

If you are using a child theme you need not activate the parent just activate the child theme. Remember to check each new version of the theme for any changes in your child theme that may have been done in the parent. Also when you update a theme just do not update the child only update the parent and all your changes will be kept.

### INSTALLING THE THEME

1. Unzip the downloaded zip file
2. You should see several files and folders depending on your theme package
3. Upload the entire Gallery/ folder to wp-content/themes/
4. Login to your dashboard >> Appearance and activate the theme - if you using WPMU, you need to go to site admin and activate the theme before it shows in Appearance
5. Your theme should be now be activated and ready for use

\*Make sure your install path is themes/ not themes/themes/thethemename/

For this theme under wp-content/themes/ you should have:

Gallery/  
Gallery-child/

### HOW DO I ADD A FAVICON?

Gallery is already set to link to a favicon all you have to do is put one in either your parent or child theme under the stylesheet directory and it must be called favicon.ico - if you are using a child remember the favicon should be under your child theme style directory.

Should you wish to remove the call to the favicon automatically just edit header.php and remove the following line 54:

```
<link rel="icon" href="<?php bloginfo('stylesheet_directory');?>/favicon.ico" type="images/x-icon" />
```

## GALLERY FAQ

### How do I add a gallery?

You have 2 options:

1. **BASIC** : Use a page template and the built in galleries with WordPress
2. **ADVANCED** : Use custom post types and create galleries and images - only way to create slideshow

### **BASIC: How do I use the gallery page template?**

1. Create a new page
2. Under page templates select gallery
3. Click add images under the editor (page editor) then upload images you want to be in gallery and add gallery
4. Save the page

### **ADVANCED: How do I use the gallery custom post type?**

1. Click **Add New** under the Gallery Image menu
2. You will now see the add new gallery post screen which is a modified post screen
3. Add a title and caption
4. Link to a gallery - galleries are similar to categories for your images
5. Under Gallery Image Setup now decide if you want to have the image show in the slideshow or not
6. Set a small image to show in the grid view
7. Set a image to show when the small image is clicked under the Popup layer image upload option
8. Next depending on if you have a partial or full width slideshow set put an image in for the slideshow
9. Save your image and you're all set

### **How do I add a category to my gallery items**

1. Click **Galleries** under the Gallery Images menu
2. Add a category

### **How do I change the design?**

1. Click **Design** under the Gallery Theme menu

## GALLERY FAQ

### How do I change the create my own colors in a design?

1. Click **Design** under the Gallery Theme menu
2. Select theme you want as a starting point
3. Click **Customization** under the Gallery Theme menu

### How do I change the background image?

1. Click **Background** under the Appearance menu.

### How do I have a custom header?

1. Click **Options** under the Gallery Theme menu
2. On the **Home Builder** tab select **Show Custom Header** to yes and click save
3. Click **Header** under the Appearance menu

### How do I set a menu?

1. Click **Menus** under the Appearance menu

### How do I set a list of gallery pages in a menu?

1. Click **Menus** under the Appearance menu
2. Pick gallery as your menu area
3. If you use a partial slideshow you can choose to have this show at the side

### How do I add a widget?

1. Click **Widgets** under the Appearance menu
